

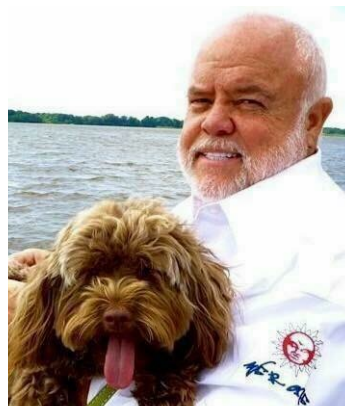
Howard University Family, I Seek Your Vote and Support.
